

- POSTAL SERVICES OF THE HOTELS IN EGYPT -

- Egypt for its size and population had perhaps the largest number of Hotel Post Offices in the world - during the late 19th and early 20th Centuries - No doubt a lot is owed to Egyptian Antiquities and the famous Cook's Tours of the Pyramids and Nile valley, but quite a large concentration of European businessmen also lived or met for business transactions especially in Cairo.
- A selection of the various types of postmarks used in these hotels during this period - along with their locations and facilities are shown including views - showing the Egyptian Post Office's foresight of need.

- SAN STEFANO HOTEL - ALEXANDRIA -

- Mainly a gambling Casino with a small hotel attached for players - Does not appear to have much used as an hotel -

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Alexandria - San Stefano Hotel and Casino

Situated on the outskirts of Alexandria not far from the sea. This hotel so far known, is likely to have opened in the summer of 1890, and served the summer residents and numerous government functions which followed the Court's transference to Alexandria during the hot season.

The special Post Office opened in May 1895 but traces of it are lost after the summer of 1916.

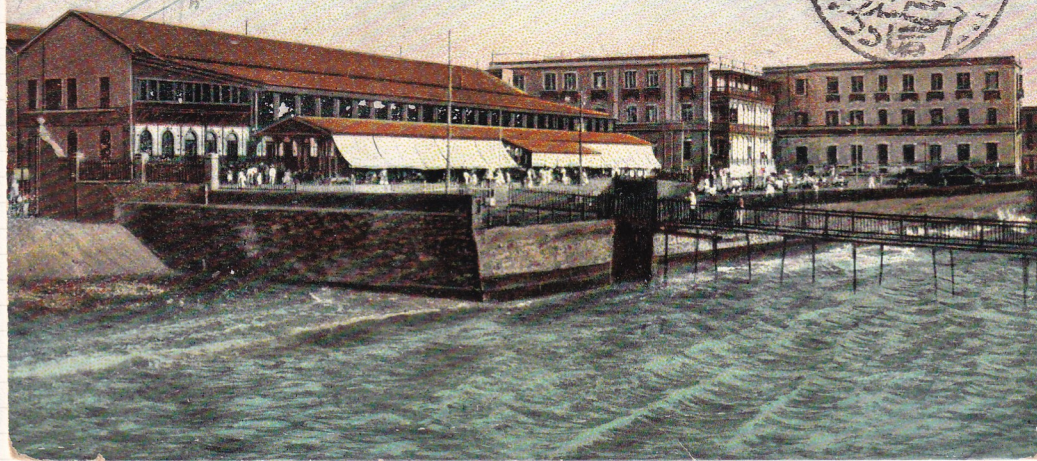
