
362 ≥ 1882 (Sep 2) ≥ with Egypt 1 pi. cancelled by "ALEXANDRIA A" duplex fine to Mr. Spence" Carr, c/o Sir Garnet Wolsey (sic) at Ismailia, forwarded to Kassassin, with on reverse bilingual "ISMAILIAH" c.d.s. good to fine and "BRITISH ARMY POST OFFICE/EGYPT" c.d.s. fair to good but damaged on opening. Also piece with Crowned Circle "PAID AT SUEZ" fine and small "SUEZ/JY 31/82" c.d.s. fine used four years after the British Post Office in Suez had been closed

Note: Lovt 363, 364, 365, 370, 371 and 375 are covers addressed to Sir William Parker, Bart. or to Lady Parker at Melford Hall, Long Melford Suffolk and were written by their son Lieutenant Hyde Parker, King's Liverpool Regiment, serving with the 2nd Bn. Royal Irish Regiment. All have Long Melford c.d.s. on reverse.

363 ⋈ — (23 Aug.) ⋈ endorsed "On Service" with Egypt 1 pi. cancelled by bi-lingual "PORT SAID" c.d.s. with another alongside, both almost fine and 27 Aug. endorsed "Not stamped. On Active Service" with bi-lingual "ISMAILIAH" c.d.s. fine and h.s. "21" slight damage and foxing, both to England

British Army Post Office/Egypt c.d.s.

- 364 🖂 1882 (SP 1) 🖂 endorsed "On Active Service. No stamps available" with c.d.s. fine (code B) and h.s. "T." both overstruck by h.s. " $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Photo
- \boxtimes (SP 4) \boxtimes similarly endorsed with c.d.s. (code B) fine and h.s. "T" and h.s. "2\frac{1}{2}". Photo S.F. 500
- △ (SP 4) Great Britain 2½d. plate 22 JE (marginal), cancelled by complete strike fine and dated part strike (code A) S.F. 150
- (SP 8) as last, a pair, EE-EF, cancelled by two part strikes (code A) S.F. 140
- — (SP 8) as last but plate 23 on piece cancelled by c.d.s. fine (code B); SP 18 (code B) and SP 25 (no code), plate 22 with clear part strikes and another copy cancelled by "BA/E" in oval of bars

- "SP 9" Egypt 10 para (creased); "SP 16" 1 pi. (both no code) and "SP 23" 1 pi. (code A and day slugs inverted) cancelled with clear part strikes
- 370 ⋈ (SP 10) ⋈ with c.d.s. fine (no code) and h.s. "T" and "2½" carefully placed clear of c.d.s. and address, but foxed and with closed slit through address and not affecting appearance. Photo S.F. 500
- 371 ⊠ (SP 17) ⊠ franked by Great Britain ½d. green and 1d. lilac (2) individually cancelled by c.d.s. with another alongside (code B) all good to fine, foxed but attractive. Photo S.F. 700


