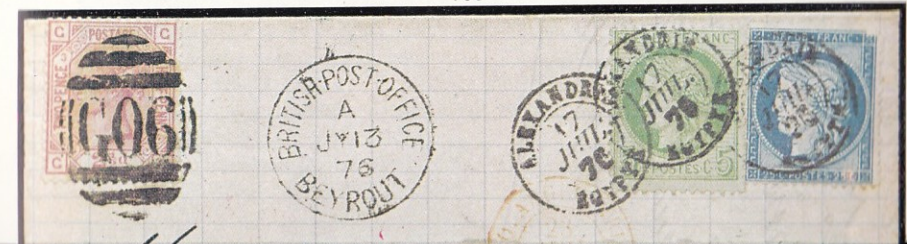

- 234 Perforated 12½: 5 pa. on 2½ pi. (3, unused, one inverted surcharge) and 10 pa. on 2½ pi. (3, unused, one inverted surcharge) and perforated 12½ × 13½ 5 pa. on 2½ pi. (3) and 10 pa. on 2½ pi. (6, two with inverted surcharges, one unused, the other used on cover) also five forgeries with three genuine for comparison, five are used S.F. 200
- 235 ★B — 5 PARAS on 2½ pi., a fresh mint block (6 × 6) S.F. 275
- 236 ○ DOPO LA PARTENZA: 1872 perf. 12½ × 13½ eleven values to 2½ pi. (2) and perf. 13½ 1 pi. and 2 pi. and 1874-75 perf. 12½, fourteen values to 5 pi. and perf. 13½ × 12½, seven values to 20 pa., also 1 pi. (3), two without perforations and another on cover on which another strike appears), all with "Dopo la Partenza" hand stamps, some in colour. (37) S.F. 250

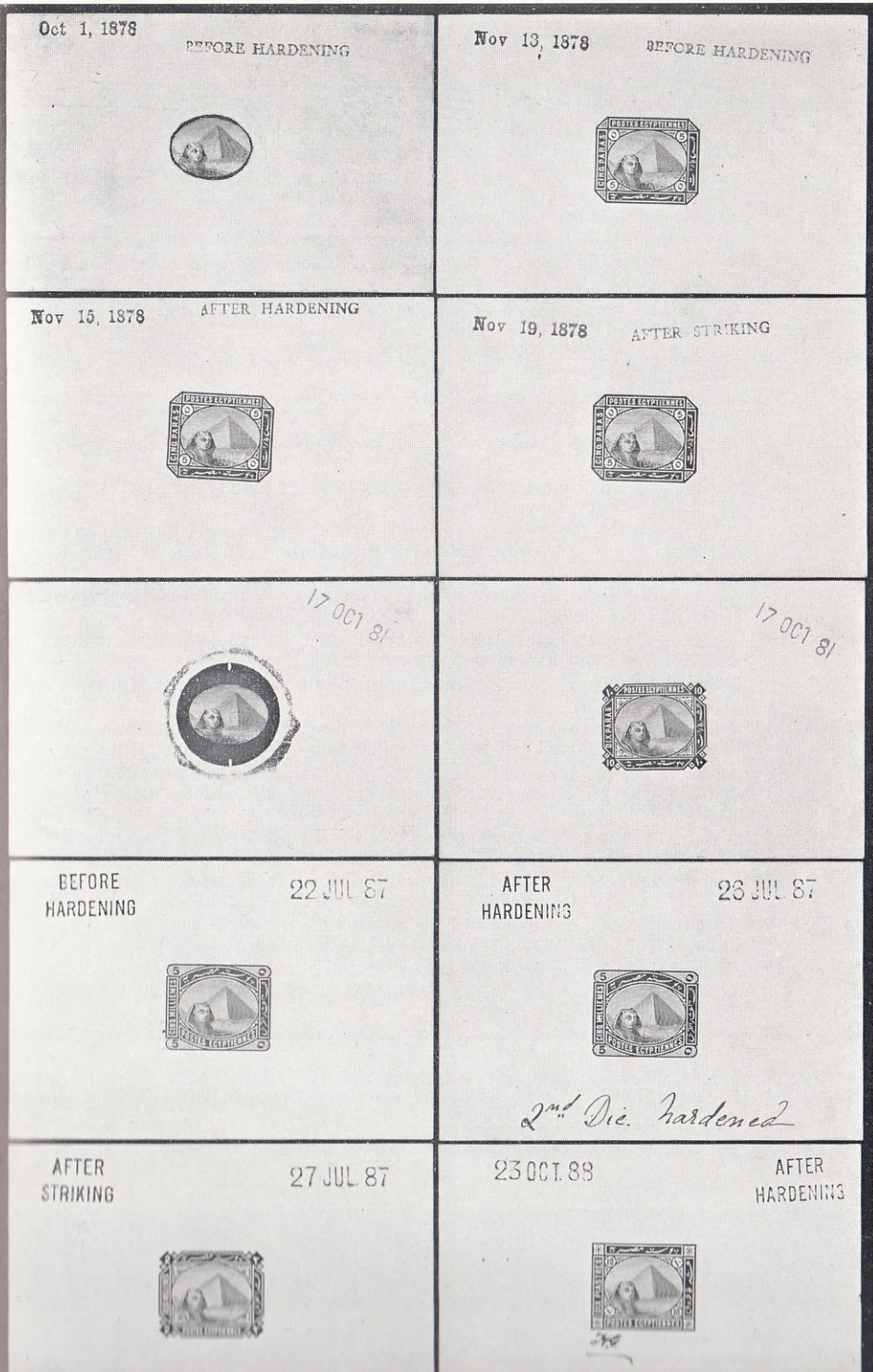

- 237 (E) 1878 20 par. handpainted in bright blue on card (33½ × 29 mm.) dated "7 AUG 78". Photo S.F. 600
- 238 (E) — 1 pi. handpainted in mauve with value tablets picked out in white on card (97 × 80 mm.) handstamped "7 AUG 78" on face and "19 SEP 78" on reverse with the note "Copy the large diagrams for the Arabic inscriptions and the Arabic numbers as the inscriptions on this design are not correctly drawn. The bottom tablet is to contain the words "Postes Egyptiennes" in Arabic; the right hand tablet the value in Arabic". Photo S.F. 600
- 239 (E) — 2 pi. handpainted in yellow and orange with some details picked out in white on card (34 × 30 mm.) dated "7 AUG 78", the face values are in each corner of the vignette. Photo S.F. 600
- 240 (E) — ditto similarly handpainted on card (97 × 80 mm.) a little stained handstamped "17 SEP 78" and with the face values at each extreme corner, the reverse is marked in the same way as in Lot 238. Photo S.F. 600



- 241 (E) 1888 10 pi. with printed vignette and hand-painted frame in mauve, on card (89 × 68 mm.) marked "Dark Violet" and dated "JULY 27TH 88". Photo S.F. 750
- 242 (E) 1893 3m. with printed vignette and handpainted frame on card (87 × 68 mm.) dated "MARCH 5 91". Photo S.F. 600
- 243 (E) Postal Stationery: 20 pa. + 20 pa. reply post card, both parts entirely hand-painted in blue; a rough pen and ink drawing of one half of a 20 pa. reply postcard and the issued card in carmine S.F. 600

362	1882 (Sep 2) with Egypt 1 pi. cancelled by "ALEXANDRIA A" duplex fine to Mr. Spence Carr, c/o Sir Garnet Wolsey (sic) at Ismailia, forwarded to Kassassin, with on reverse bilingual "ISMAILIAH" c.d.s. good to fine and "BRITISH ARMY POST OFFICE/EGYPT" c.d.s. fair to good but damaged on opening. Also piece with Crowned Circle "PAID AT SUEZ" fine and small "SUEZ/JY 31/82" c.d.s. fine used four years after the British Post Office in Suez had been closed	S.F. 400

Note: Lots 363, 364, 365, 370, 371 and 375 are covers addressed to Sir William Parker, Bart. or to Lady Parker at Melford Hall, Long Melford Suffolk and were written by their son Lieutenant Hyde Parker, King's Liverpool Regiment, serving with the 2nd Bn. Royal Irish Regiment. All have Long Melford c.d.s. on reverse.

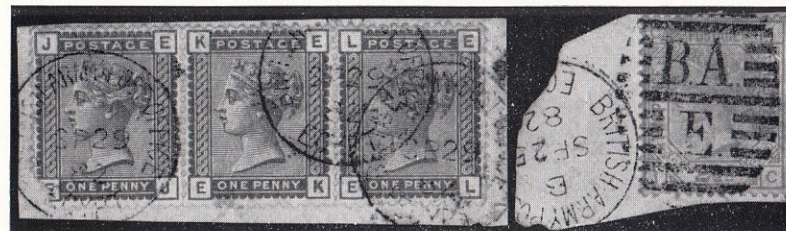

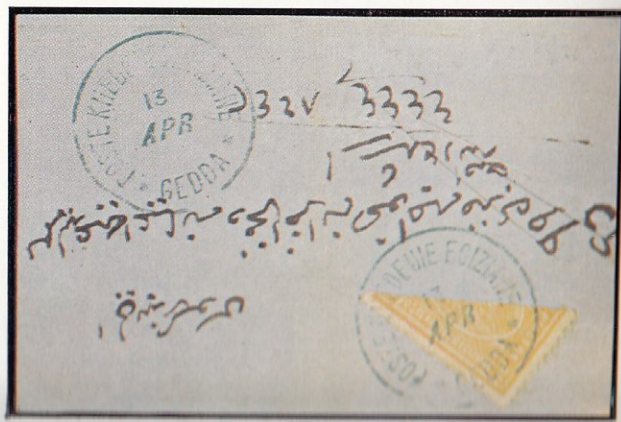
